John Bernardino, plumber, stricken

John J. Bernardino, 40, of 193 Washington St., a plumber, suffered an apparent heart attack late yesterday afternoon while

working and was pronounced dead on arrival at Morton Hospital. He was the husband of Linda V. (Lopes) Bernardino.

A member of various bowling leagues in the area, he was employed by Boyle Plumbing and Heating Co. and was working on a job in the rear of the former Park Hotel building when stricken.

He also worked part-time at Capeway Bowl in Raynham and was previously employed as a foreman for the sewer department for 17 years.

Born in North Dighton, he was son of the late John and Mary (Souza) Bernardino and had lived in Taunton most of his life.
