

# Life, death just hours 1-12/82 TA apart for local family

Just hours before her first great-grandchild was born last night at Morton Hospital, Mrs. Lillian (Araujo) Carvalho, 61, of 15 Munroe St., died suddenly at Morton after suffering a massive coronary.

The baby, a girl, was born shortly after Mrs. Carvalho's death to her granddaughter, Mrs. Richard (Dawn Weiss) Medeiros.
