

MANUEL F. DIOGO

Manuel F. Diogo, 84, of 22 Roosevelt St., a native of Portugal, died this morning at Morton Hospital following a lengthy illness. He was the husband of Rose L. (Lewis) Diogo.

For many years he was employed in the maintenance department of the former Ansonia Mills of East Taunton. He later worked at Wheaton College.

A U.S. Army veteran of World War Two, he served with Company "D" of the 315 M.J. Battalion. He was a member of the Silver City Barracks, 2115, World War One veterans. Diogo also belonged to the David F. Adams Post 611, Veterans of Foreign War.

He was a member of Our Lady of Lourdes Church, and belonged to the Holy Ghost Society of East Taunton.

Born in Lisbon, Portugal, son of the late Francisco and Casmira (Conceicao) Diogo, he came to this country as a young man and had resided in Taunton ever since.
