

**EDWARD MEDEIROS**

ATTLEBORO - Edward Medeiros, 62, of 8 Beacon St., Taunton, and husband of Lillian R. (Banus) Medeiros, died Saturday afternoon at Sturdy Memorial Hospital following a short illness.

Born in Taunton, he was the son of the late Manuel A. and Georgianna (Furtado) Medeiros.

He was employed as a furniture salesman for over 20 years with the former Dana Furniture Store in Taunton. He was also employed with Parker Brothers, retiring in January.
