EAST PROVIDENCE — Manuel Mello, 74, of 90 Wampanoag Trail, died yesterday morning in Rhode Island Hospital shortly after being admitted after suffering a heart attack at home. He was the husband of Olive (Silva) Mello.

Born in Providence, a son of the late Frank and Mary Mello, he lived in East Providence 52 years.

He was a plasterer most of his life, and worked for the City of East Providence Department of Public Works for eight years, retiring in 1971 due to illness.
