C. Lynwood Mills

FALL RIVER — C. Lynwood Mills, 66, of 41 Goddard St. died unexpectedly Wednesday. He was the husband of Hazel (Handfield) Mills and son of the late John and Charlotte (Stott) Mills.

He died at Charlton Memorial Hospital.

He was born in Fall River and briefly lived in Jewett City, Conn. He was a former member of Union United Methodist Church and was active in its leadership for many years.

He was an active member and former president of the Greater Fall River Council of Churches and formerly was active in the New England Southeastern Methodist Conference.

Mr. Mills graduated from Norwich Free Academy, Norwich, Conn., and received a bachelor's degree in commerce from Bryant College in Smithfield, R.I., in 1938. Mr. Mills taught accounting and auditing at the former Thibodeau's Business College in Fall River and was former president of the National Association of Cost Accountants.

In 1937, he began his career with Pacific Oil; he was its president for 13 years and chairman of the board from 1974-79, when he retired.

Mr. Mills was a member of the Little Theatre of Greater Fall River and the Kiwanis Club of Fall River. He was also active in the Citizens' Scholarship Foundation of Greater Fall River and the United Way of Greater Fall River.

He was a member of the Greater Fall River Chapter of the American Red Cross and the Greater Fall River Regional Task Force. He was a former board member of the Deaconess Home and Homemakers.

Survivors include his widow; a daughter, Carolyn A. J. Mills of Assonet; a son, Jeffrey C. of Arlington, Texas; two grandchildren; two nieces and a nephew.
