BRISTOL — George A. Oliver, 53, of 20 Brookwood Drive, an electrician for the Kaiser Aluminum Co., Portsmouth, for more than 37 years, died Friday at the Jane Brown Building of Rhode Island Hospital. He was the husband of Pauline (Olivera) Oliver.
