DURVALINO PINARRETA

Durvalino B. Pinarreta, 38, of 12 Pine St., a foreman and native of the Azores, died suddenly Sunday at Morton Hospital a few hours after being taken to there from his home by the Taunton Police Ambulance.

Dr. James N. Shamey, Bristol County medical examiner from Attleboro, listed his death as due to coronary heart disease. Pinarreta was the husband of Maria L. (Pimentel) Pinarreta.

He was employed as a foreman at F.B. Rogers Silver Co. A communicant of St. Anthony's Church, he was a member of the Portuguese-American Civic Club and the Taunton Eagles Soccer Club.

Born in Pavoacao, Sao Miguel, Azores, son of Manuel Medeiros Pinarreta and Eugenia (Brandao) Pinarreta, he had resided in Taunton for the past 13 years.

Besides his wife and parents, he leaves three sons, Mario G. Pinarreta, Steven Pinarreta and Kenneth Pinarreta, all of Taunton; two brothers, Luis B. Pinarreta of Taunton, and Antonio M. Pinarreta of New Bedford; one sister, Deotilla Brandao Pinarreta of Sao Miguel, Azores; and several nieces and nephews.
