David A. Rogers, 37, of 519 Staples St., East Taunton, stricken suddenly Wednesday, was dead on arrival at Morton Hospital. He was the husband of Mary Jane (McCaffrey) Rogers.

A self-employed accountant, he was president and treasurer of Associate Management, Inc. He was appointed a trustee of Bristol Community College in 1982 by former Gov. Edward J. King.

He was a 1964 graduate of Msgr. James Coyle High School. He also was graduated from Bristol Community College, and earned a bachelor's degree in accounting from Southeastern Massachusetts University.

He was a communicant of Holy Family Church and a member of the SMU Alumni Association Board, Elks Lodge 150 of Taunton, the Babe Ruth League, and Ward Five Athletic Club.

Born in Taunton, he was the son of the late Antone and Helen (Cabral) Rogers.
