Joseph Teixeira, 70, of 8 Shephard St., a retired security guard, died suddenly Monday at his home. He was the husband of Genevieve (Dlugoleski) Teixeira.

Dr. William H. Bennett, medical examiner who responded with city police to the call at Teixeira's home, said he died of natural causes.

Until retiring in 1964, he had been employed by Pinkerton Security Service as a guard. A U.S. Army veteran of World War Two, he was a former member of the American Legion Post No. 103.

Born in East Taunton, son of the late Manuel and Maria (Silya) Teixeira, he was a communicant of St. Mary's Church, and was a life-long city resident.

Besides his wife, he leaves two brothers, Frank Teixeira of Middleboro, and Charles Teixeira of North Easton; and several nieces and nephews.
