Robert A. Viera, 47, husband of Barbara (Bailey) Viera of Solomon, Ariz., died August 23 at the Mount Graham Community Hospital following a long illness.

Born in Taunton, son of Antone and Rosena (Murphy) Viera, he was educated in Taunton schools. He graduated from Boston University and later earned a master's degree in education at Bridgewater State College. He also attended Framingham College for further studies.

A resident of Solomon for the past six years, he had previously lived in Medfield and Framingham, Mass.

He was employed by the Medfield Public School system as principal from 1963 to 1974, when he left for health reasons. A communicant of St. Rose of Lima Church in Safford, he was also a retired captain in the United States Army Reserve.

Besides his wife and parents, he is survived by a son, Robert C. Viera, both of Solomon; a sister, Mrs. George (Judith M.) Costa of Taunton; and several aunts, uncles and cousins.

A funeral mass was held at St. Rose of Lima Church Monday, August 27.
