WAREHAM — Louise H. Westgate, 93, of Wareham died Tuesday after a brief illness. She was the widow of Charles H. Westgate.

She died at Tobey Hospital.

She was born in South Weymouth and lived in Wareham most of her life. She was a member of the East Rochester Congregational Church and was a member of its Church Service Circle.

Mrs. Westgate was a 1911 graduate of Bridgewater Normal School and began her teaching career in the Pierceville School in East Bridgewater. She also taught on Martha's Vineyard and Mattapoisett and retired at 70 after 16 years in the Wareham school system.

She was a member of the Rochester School Committee and directed Rochester's 250th anniversary pageant. She also was a member of the Wareham Bicentennial Committee in 1939.

She was in her 75th year of Grange membership, having been past master of the West Wareham Grange and the first lecturer of the Sippican Pomona where she held the title of Chaplain Emeritus.

She was an active member of the Wareham Monday Club and for many years served as a volunteer and clerical aide at Tobey Hospital. She organized the Friendly Reading Club at the Roland Thatcher Nursing Home.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Oliver Millett of Whitman and Shirley Westgate of Wareham; and several nieces and nephews.
